Since THE AP-RCEM began with a number of willing individuals, it has been intent all the time to ensure that those people who were initially involved in its extraordinary gradual establishment operate powerful, transparent and functional management mechanisms so that the work of THE AP-RCEM is transparent, reassurable the responsibility of constituencies it represents and can create legitimacy over time. It is an important precursor to the participation in effective development outcomes, which are jointly developed and belong to civil society in a broad partnership necessary for the implementation of the future SDDS. The overall objective with THE AP-RCEM is to develop better and more effective ways of engagement and participation. As with the intention of the mechanism, greater public engagement in managing sustainable development is an important key objective, as it can provide the necessary legitimacy and accountability for the decisions and policies that governments adopt. In this respect, participation is an important democratic right and an essential part of development fairness. In addition to participation as a final objective, the AP-RCEM is also to work towards better results and better results in sustainable development processes, i.e. the intention that participation produces better development outcomes. There are therefore two interrelated objectives of participation conceived by AP-RCEM. The current literature on participation discusses typology, which can illustrate these two objectives: (i) participation and (ii) participation as a means of achieving better development outcomes. A useful example can be obtained from Bass, Dalal-clayton, & Pretty (1995), which conducted an extensive review of plans and strategies formulated with varying levels of participation by other stakeholders in the 1990s and early 2000s. A recent study by the Norwegian Development Cooperation Agency (NORAD) analyses various participatory typologies and provides useful additions to the discussion on the use of participation to create ownership, shopping and harmonisation of national development goals. (Norad, 2013). Such typology can also illustrate the expected results, i.e. either the results of capacity, empowerment or significant development. We combine dual objectives, as shown below, to clarify that the intention with AP-RCEM is twofold: to ensure that participation is legal, transparent and overhead, but also that in the long term it can help produce better development results. At present, AP-RCEM activities are somewhere in the middle of the box where participation is increasing. We believe that the types of participation under the first objective are necessary to achieve participation in the achievement of the broad responsibility needed to mobilise action on future SDS. Of course, the desire is for THE AP-RCEM to become one of the mechanisms that governments can use at several levels in the longer term to cooperate with TSOs (and vice versa) as a transparent forum to set appropriate priorities for the global SDDS, as they will be re-interpreted to meet the region.
